Announcement of Resolutions of the 17th Meeting of the 8th Session of the Board of Supervisors

The Company and all members of its board of supervisors hereby confirm that all information disclosed herein is true, accurate and complete with no false or misleading statement or material omission.

The 17th Meeting of the 8th Session of the Board of Supervisors of ADAMA Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as the “Company”) was held via an on-site and video conference meeting on April 28, 2021 following notifications sent to all the supervisors by email on April 26, 2021. Three supervisors were entitled to attend the meeting and three supervisors attended.

1. Proposal Confirming the Q1 2021 Report

After approval by the shareholders, the above two candidates will constitute the 9th Board of Supervisors together with the employee representative supervisor elected by the Employees' Representative Congress of the Company.
