CHARACTERISTICS OF GEM OF THE STOCK EXCHANGE OF HONG KONG LIMITED (THE “STOCK EXCHANGE”)

CORPORATE GOVERNANCE

企業管治

The Board recognises the importance of incorporating elements of good corporate governance in the management structures and internal control procedures of the Group so as to achieve effective accountability. The Directors consider that the Company has applied the principles and complied with all the applicable code provisions set out in the Corporate Governance Code as set out in Appendix C1 to the GEM Listing Rules (the “Code”) during the six months ended 30 June 2026 and up to the date of this report (the “Relevant Period”).

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR DIRECTORS' SECURITIES TRANSACTIONS

The Company has adopted a code of conduct regarding securities transactions by directors on terms no less exacting than the required standard of dealings as set out in Rules 5.48 to 5.67 of the GEM Listing Rules. The Company has made specific enquiry to all Directors and all Directors have confirmed that they have complied with the required standard of dealings and the code of conduct regarding directors' securities transactions adopted by the Company during the six months ended 30 June 2026.

EVENTS AFTER THE REPORTING PERIOD

The Board is not aware of any significant events affecting the Group, which have occurred subsequent to 30 June 2026 and up to the date of this report.

PURCHASE, SALE OR REDEMPTION OF THE COMPANY'S LISTED SECURITIES

Neither the Company nor any of its subsidiaries redeemed, purchased or sold any of the Company's listed securities during the six months ended 30 June 2026.

AUDIT COMMITTEE

The Company has established the Audit Committee on 21 July 2017 in compliance with Rule 5.28 of the GEM Listing Rules. Among other things, the primary duties of the Audit Committee are to review and supervise the Company's financial reporting process, internal control system and risk management system and to provide advice and recommendations to the Board on the appointment, reappointment and removal of external auditors.

The Audit Committee consists of three independent non-executive Directors, namely Ms. Pan Jianli, Mr. Zhang Yumo and Dr. Li Ling. Ms. Pan Jianli is the chairperson of the Audit Committee.

The Audit Committee has reviewed the accounting principles and practices adopted by the Group and discussed the financial reporting matters with senior management of the Company relating to the preparation of the unaudited condensed consolidated financial statements of the Group for the six months ended 30 June 2026. This report has been reviewed by the Audit Committee, which was of the opinion that the preparation of such results complied with the applicable accounting principles and practices adopted by the Group and that adequate disclosure has been made.

審核委員會

本公司已遵照GEM上市規則第5.28條於二零一七年七月二十一日成立審核委員會。審核委員會的主要職責為(其中包括)檢討及監督本公司的財務申報過程、內部監控制度及風險管理系統，並就外部核數師的委任、續聘及罷免向董事會提供意見及建議。

審核委員會成員包括三名獨立非執行董事潘建麗女士、張宇模先生及李玲博士。潘建麗女士為審核委員會主席。

審核委員會已審閱本集團所採納的會計原則及慣例，並與本公司高級管理層討論與編製本集團截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月的未經審核簡明合併財務報表相關的財務申報事宜。本報告已經審核委員會審閱，其認為編製該等業績符合本集團採納的適用會計原則及常規，並已作充分披露。

SHARE OPTION SCHEME

On 17 October 2017, the Company adopted a share option scheme (the “Share Option Scheme”). Under the Share Option Scheme, the Board may, at its absolute discretion and on such terms as it may think fit, grant share options to any Eligible Person (who is (i)(a) any director or proposed director (whether executive or non-executive, including any independent non-executive director), employee or proposed employee (whether full time or part time) of, or (b) any individual for the time being seconded to work for, any member of the Group or any substantial shareholder or any company controlled by a substantial shareholder (a “Category A Eligible Person”); or (ii) any person or entity that provides research, development or other technological support or any advisory, consultancy, professional or other services to any member of the Group (a “Category B Eligible Person”) and, for the purposes of the Share Option Scheme, shall include any company controlled by one or more persons belonging to any of the above classes of participants, collectively the “Eligible Persons”) to subscribe at a price calculated in accordance with the Share Option Scheme for such number of Shares as it may determine in accordance with the terms of the Share Option Scheme.

Purpose of the Share Option Scheme

The purpose of the Share Option Scheme is to enable the Company to grant share options to the selected Eligible Persons as incentives or rewards for their contribution or potential contribution to the development and growth of the Group.

購股權計劃

於二零一七年十月十七日，本公司採納一項購股權計劃（「購股權計劃」）。根據購股權計劃，董事會可全權酌情及按其認為合適之有關條款，向任何合資格人士（指「A類合資格人士」即(i)本集團任何成員公司或任何主要股東或主要股東控制的任何公司的(a)任何董事或擬任董事（不論為執行董事或非執行董事，包括任何獨立非執行董事）、僱員或擬任僱員（不論為全職或兼職），或(b)當時借調為其工作的任何個人；或(ii)「B類合資格人士」即向本集團任何成員公司提供研究、開發或其他技術支持或任何顧問、諮詢、專業或其他服務的任何人士或實體；就購股權計劃而言，包括屬於上述任何一類參與者的一名或多名人士控制的任何公司，統稱「合資格人士」）授出購股權，以按購股權計劃所載方法計算之價格認購董事會根據購股權計劃條款釐定之有關數目的股份。

購股權計劃之目的

購股權計劃之目的為讓本公司向選定的合資格人士授予購股權，作為彼等對本集團之發展及增長所作出或將會作出之貢獻之激勵或獎賞。

Total number of Shares available under the Share Option Scheme

The total number of Shares which may be issued upon the exercise of all share options to be granted under the Share Option Scheme and any other share option schemes of the Company must not in aggregate exceed 10% of the total issued share capital of the Company as at 17 October 2017, being the date on which the Share Option Scheme was adopted (i.e. 480,000,000 Shares).

On 31 January 2018, options to subscribe for a total of 21,000,000 shares with a nominal amount of US\$0.01 each in the share capital of the Company were granted under the Share Option Scheme at the exercise price of HK\$1.16 per share. As at the date of this report, 3,990,000 share options have been granted under the Share Option Scheme to entitle the holders of these share options to subscribe for a total of 3,990,000 Shares, representing 0.77% of the issued Shares of the Company.

The number of share options available for grant under the scheme mandate as at 1 January 2026 and 30 June 2026 was 31,000,000 and 31,000,000, respectively.

購股權計劃項下可發行的股份總數

因行使根據購股權計劃及本公司任何其他購股權計劃將予授出之所有購股權而可予發行之股份總數合共不得超過本公司於二零一七年十月十七日(即採納購股權計劃之日期)已發行股本總額之10%(即480,000,000股股份)。

於二零一八年一月三十一日，根據購股權計劃授出認購本公司股本中總額為21,000,000股每股面值0.01美元之購股權，行使價為每股1.16港元。於本報告日期，根據購股權計劃已授出3,990,000份購股權可賦予購股權持有人認購總共3,990,000股股份的權利，即佔本公司已發行股份的0.77%。

於二零二六年一月一日及二零二六年六月三十日，根據計劃授權可供授出的購股權數目分別為31,000,000份及31,000,000份。

Maximum entitlement of each eligible participant

The maximum number of Shares issued and to be issued upon the exercise of the share options granted under the Share Option Scheme and any other share option schemes of the Company to any Eligible Person(s) (including cancelled, exercised and outstanding share options), in any 12-month period up to the date of grant shall not exceed 1% of the number of Shares in issue, unless (i) a circular is despatched to the Shareholders; (ii) the Shareholders approve the grant of the share options in excess of the 1% limit referred to in this paragraph; and (iii) the relevant Eligible Persons and their associates shall abstain from voting. The number and terms (including the exercise price) of share options to be granted to such Eligible Person(s) must be fixed before Shareholders' approval.

Time of exercise of option

A share option may be exercised in accordance with the terms of the Share Option Scheme at any time during a period commencing on such date on or after the date on which the share option is granted as the Board may determine in granting the share options and expiring at the close of business on such date as the Board may determine in granting the share options but in any event shall not exceed ten (10) years from the date of grant (which is the date of offer of grant if the offer for the grant of the share options is accepted).

Vesting period

The Company may specify any vesting period for which a share option must be held before it can be exercised at the time of grant of the share options.

Acceptance of offers

An offer for the grant of share options must be accepted within thirty (30) days inclusive of the day on which such offer is made. The amount payable by the grantee of the share options to the Company on acceptance of the offer for the grant of share options is HK\$1.00.

各合資格參與人可認購的股份數目上限

因行使根據購股權計劃及本公司任何其他購股權計劃授予任何合資格人士之購股權（包括已註銷、已行使及尚未行使之購股權）而發行及將予發行之股份總數，於截至授出當日止任何十二個月期間，不得超過已發行股份數目之1%，除非(i)一份通函已寄發予股東；(ii)股東批准授出超過本段所述之1%上限之購股權；及(iii)有關合資格人士及其聯繫人須放棄投票。將授予合資格人士之購股權之數目條款（包括行使價）必須於股東批准前釐定。

購股權的行使時間

購股權可根據購股權計劃之條款，於董事會授出購股權時決定之日起及於授出購股權之後起，直至董事會於授出購股權時決定之日及結束營業止之期間內隨時行使，惟在任何情況下該期間不得超過授出當日（倘授出購股權之要約獲接納則為授出要約當日）起計十(10)年。

歸屬期

本公司可在授出購股權時指定購股權行使之前必須持有之任何歸屬期。

接納要約

授出購股權之要約必須在提出該等要約當日起三十(30)日（包括當日）予以接納。購股權承授人於接納授出購股權之要約時，須支付本公司之金額為1.00港元。

Exercise price per Share for the exercise of a share option

The exercise price per Share payable on the exercise of a share option is to be determined by the Board provided always that it shall be at least the higher of (i) the closing price of the Shares as stated in the daily quotations sheet issued by the Stock Exchange on the date of grant (which is deemed to be the date of Board meeting for approving the grant of options), which must be a business day; and (ii) the average closing price of the Shares as stated in the daily quotations sheets issued by the Stock Exchange for the five (5) business days immediately preceding the date of offer of grant, provided that the exercise price per Share shall in no event be less than the nominal amount of the Share.

Remaining life of the Share Option Scheme

The Share Option Scheme will remain in force for a period of ten (10) years commencing on 17 October 2017, the date on which the Share Option Scheme was adopted by Shareholders in general meeting, and shall expire at the close of business on the day immediately preceding the tenth anniversary thereof unless terminated earlier by Shareholders in general meeting.

The Company may by resolution in general meeting or the Board may at any time terminate the Share Option Scheme and in such event no further share option shall be offered but the provisions of the Share Option Scheme shall remain in force to the extent necessary to give effect to the exercise of any share option granted prior to the termination or otherwise as may be required in accordance with the provisions of the Share Option Scheme. Upon the termination, share options granted prior to such termination shall continue to be valid and exercisable in accordance with the Share Option Scheme.

行使購股權的每股股份行使價

行使購股權時應付之每股股份的行使價由董事會釐定，惟不得低於以下較高價：(i) 在授出當日（該日將被視為批准授出購股權之董事會會議日期）（必須為營業日）股份於聯交所發出之日報表上所報收市價；及(ii) 緊接授出要約當日前五(5)個營業日股份於聯交所發出之日報表上所報平均收市價，惟在任何情況下每股股份之行使價不得低於股份之面值。

購股權計劃的餘下年限

購股權計劃自二零一七年十月十七日（即股東在股東大會上採納購股權計劃當日）起十(10)年期間一直有效，並於緊接十週年前一日營業時間結束時屆滿（股東於股東大會上提早終止者除外）。

本公司可經股東大會通過之決議案或董事會隨時終止購股權計劃，而自此之後再無購股權可予授出，惟購股權計劃之條文仍將維持相當程度之效力，足以令在購股權計劃終止前已授出之任何購股權的行使，或根據購股權計劃之條文規定之其他方面仍然有效。該終止於終止前授出之購股權仍可根據購股權計劃生效及行使。

BUSINESS REVIEW

The Group is engaged in research and development, production and sales of new materials such as ITO film, Smart Polymer-Dispersed Liquid Crystals (“Smart PDLC”) products, and possesses vertically integrated capabilities spanning “ITO coating – PDLC formulation development – coating production – sheet processing – glass lamination”. The Group uses ITO film as one of the main materials for the development of downstream products, namely: (i) Smart PDLC Film (Polymer-Dispersed Liquid Crystals film) series products; and (ii) Smart Light-adjusting Projection series products. The Group is one of the few integrated manufacturers in the PRC that is capable of independent research and development, production and sales of ITO film, Smart PDLC Film, Light-adjusting Glass and multimedia projection system products.

In the first half of 2026, the Group's orders for ITO film, building light-adjusting film and automotive light-adjusting film businesses recorded an increase across-the-board; the sales volume increased significantly, the product income structure was continuously optimized, and automotive light-adjusting film became the most promising profit growth driver of the Company. At the same time, the Group actively established an automatic production line and implemented technology improvement of existing equipment, which effectively reduced labor costs while improving production efficiency, and the average output per person increased significantly compared with the same period of the previous year, achieving continuous improvement.

ITO film can be applied in a variety of products (including touch screens, smart light-adjusting film products, flexible displays, wearable devices, etc.) by virtue of its advantages of flexibility, transparency and conductivity. The Group's ITO film customers are primarily domestic touch-screen device manufacturers. Revenue from sales of ITO film was RMB11.3 million for the six months ended 30 June 2026, which represented an increase of RMB3.2 million or 39.5% from RMB8.1 million for the same period in 2025.

業務回顧

本集團從事ITO導電膜、智能聚合物分散液晶（「智能液晶調光」）產品等新型材料的研發、生產及銷售，具備「ITO鍍膜－PDLC配方開發－塗布生產－片材加工－玻璃夾膠」垂直整合能力。本集團使用ITO導電膜作為主要材料之一來開發下游產品，即(i)智能液晶調光膜（聚合物分散液晶）系列產品；及(ii)智能調光投影系列產品，本集團是中國為數不多具備自主研發、生產及銷售ITO導電膜、智能液晶調光膜、調光玻璃、多媒體投影系統產品的綜合製造商。

於二零二六年上半年，本集團ITO導電膜、建築用調光膜、汽車用調光膜業務訂單實現全面上漲，銷售額顯著提升，產品收入結構不斷優化，汽車用調光膜成為本公司最具前景的利潤增長點。同時，本集團積極搭建自動化產線，實施原有設備技改升級，在提高生產效率的同時有效減少人工成本，人均產量較去年同期提升明顯，實現持續向好。

ITO導電膜憑借柔性透明和導電特性等優點，可以應用於多種產品（包括觸摸屏、智能調光產品、柔性顯示器、可穿戴設備等）。本集團的ITO導電膜客戶主要為國內觸摸屏設備製造商。截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月的ITO導電膜銷售收入為人民幣11.3百萬元，較二零二五年同期的人民幣8.1百萬元增加人民幣3.2百萬元或39.5%。

Smart liquid crystal light-adjusting film, also known as Smart PDLC Film (Polymer Dispersed Liquid Crystal Film), can be adjusted from milky white, hazy, semi-transparent and opaque to colorless and transparent after being electrified. Smart PDLC Film can be used in windows and glass to control light penetration. Smart PDLC Film can be integrated into Smart PDLC glass after being compounded by high temperature and high pressure adhesive, or directly attached to the original glass surface, so that users can switch between transparency and privacy mode with one key, and can also control the light transmittance by adjusting the voltage of smart light-adjusting film. Smart PDLC series products cover building light-adjusting film, automotive light-adjusting film and light-adjusting products for consumer electronics. The customers are mainly contractors of construction companies and developers, automobile OEMs, automobile glass manufacturers and consumer electronics manufacturers. Revenue from sales of Smart PDLC series products was RMB70.7 million for the six months ended 30 June 2026, which represented an increase of RMB14.9 million or 26.7% from RMB55.8 million for the same period in 2025.

Others include sales of other materials and products. The revenue from other products was RMB13.0 million for the six months ended 30 June 2026, which represented an increase of RMB6.6 million or 103.1% from RMB6.4 million for the same period in 2025.

Our Group strives to manufacture and supply high quality products to our customers, and our Directors believe that our Group is a reputable supplier of ITO film and Smart PDLC series products in the PRC. The key operating subsidiary of the Company was ranked as a leading manufacturer of Smart PDLC products in the PRC in terms of market share by revenue. During the six months ended 30 June 2026, our revenue has increased by 35.3% as compared to the same period in 2025. At the same time, the profit attributable to owners of the Group for the six months ended 30 June 2026 increased to RMB12.9 million from RMB8.4 million for the six months ended 30 June 2025, which represented an increase across-the-board in sales volume for the same period in 2025.

智能液晶調光膜也被稱為PDLC Film (Polymer Dispersed Liquid Crystal Film，聚合物分散液晶膜)，通電後，智能液晶調光膜可由乳白色、朦朧、半透明及不透明狀調節成無色及透明狀，可用於窗戶及玻璃，以控制光線穿透。智能液晶調光膜經高溫高壓夾膠復合後一體成型為智能液晶調光玻璃，或直接貼附於原有玻璃表面，用戶實現透明與霧化的一鍵切換，也可通過調節智能調光膜的電壓控制透光性。智能液晶調光系列產品涵蓋建築用調光膜、汽車用調光膜、消費電子類調光產品，客戶主要為建築公司及開發商的承包商、汽車主機廠及汽車玻璃製造商、消費電子廠商。截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月，智能液晶調光系列產品的銷售收入為人民幣70.7百萬元，較二零二五年同期的人民幣55.8百萬元增加人民幣14.9百萬元或26.7%。

其他包括其他材料及產品銷售。截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月，來自其他產品的收入為人民幣13.0百萬元，較二零二五年同期的人民幣6.4百萬元增加人民幣6.6百萬元或103.1%。

本集團致力於製造及向客戶供應優質產品，董事相信本集團是中國ITO導電膜及智能液晶調光系列產品的知名供應商。按收入所佔市場份額計算，本公司的主要營運附屬公司在中國智能液晶調光產品製造商中名列前茅。截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月，本集團的收入較二零二五年同期上升35.3%。同時，截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月，本集團擁有人應佔溢利從截至二零二五年六月三十日止六個月的人民幣8.4百萬元上升至人民幣12.9百萬元，較二零二五年同期銷售額實現全面上揚。

OUTLOOK AND PROSPECTS

In view of the changing market trends and customers' preferences, the Directors consider that as one of the market participants active in the technology industry, it is pivotal for the Group's business to invest considerable resources in research and development (including identifying new materials and applications), which is conducive to maintaining the Group's dominant position in the technology sector and opening up new business growth drivers, so as to enhance or maintain the Group's competitiveness. The Directors believe that the current market demand of the Group by market share relating to its ITO film and Smart PDLC series products is a testament to the broad application prospects and good profit growth trend of its products.

Looking ahead to the second half of 2026, the Group will continue to focus on different application scenarios and customer demands, further intensify its research and development efforts, promote the deep integration of technological innovation and industrial upgrading, and accelerate its extension into the high-value-added new materials sector, thereby providing strong support for expanding market share and improving profitability. The Group will develop branches of light-adjusting film technology featuring unique properties and functions, conduct in-depth research on technologies such as DDPDLC thin film through industry-academia-research cooperation and other means, strategically positioning itself in cutting-edge products such as automotive light-adjusting film and high-performance shading black Smart PDLC thin film. In addition, the Group will enrich its product categories, continuously expand the application fields of Smart PDLC products, build a sound intellectual property protection system, and promote the deep integration of technological innovation and industrial upgrading.

前景及展望

鑒於不斷變化的市場趨勢以及客戶偏好需求，董事認為，作為活躍於技術行業的市場參與者之一，將大量資源投入到研發（包括識別新材料及應用）對本集團的業務至關重要，有利於保持在技術領域的優勢地位，開闢新的業務增長點，此舉將提升或保持本集團的競爭力。董事相信，按與本集團ITO導電膜及智能液晶調光系列產品有關的市場份額計，本集團目前的市場需求佐證了旗下產品具備廣闊的應用前景與良好的盈利增長趨勢。

展望二零二六年下半年，本集團將繼續圍繞不同應用場景和客戶需求，持續加大研發力度，推動技術創新與產業升級深度融合，加速向高附加值新型材料領域延伸，為擴大市場份額和提高盈利能力提供有力支持。開發具備獨特性能與功能的調光膜技術分支，通過產學研合作等方式，深入研究DDPDLC薄膜，重點佈局汽車用調光膜、高性能遮光性黑色PDLC薄膜等前沿產品，豐富旗下產品種類，持續擴展智能液晶調光產品的應用領域，構建完善的知識產權保護體系，推動技術創新與產業升級深度融合。

The Company is committed to gradually realizing product iterative upgrading and market diversification development through continuous exploration and research and development of new technologies, new products and new processes, and will strive to transform our business model from a TP factory that sells through construction sector channels targeting small and medium-sized enterprises and private business owners to a supplier capable of serving the world's top automobile glass manufacturers, so as to improve the market share and influence of our products in the global market.

The Company believes that the products of the Group will be gradually used in more business fields, and the market share of the products of the Group will continue to expand in the future based on this trend. While diversifying our businesses to meet the challenges, the Group will prudently expand our production lines and carry out research and development projects after carefully analyzing the market dynamics and trends to meet the expected future market demand. At the same time, the Directors will pay close attention to economic changes, maintain prudent and steady strategies, and actively respond to the challenges and opportunities ahead.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Revenue

Our revenue was RMB95.1 million for the six months ended 30 June 2026, which represented an increase of RMB24.8 million, or 35.3% from RMB70.3 million for the same period in 2025. The increase was mainly attributable to an increase in sales volume of Smart PDLC products.

Cost of Sales and Gross Profit

Our cost of sales was RMB64.0 million for the six months ended 30 June 2026, which represented an increase of RMB22.8 million, or 55.3% from RMB41.2 million for the same period in 2025. The increase in cost of sales was mainly due to an increase in sales volume and the higher price of raw materials.

本公司致力通過不斷探索和研發新技術、新產品、新工藝，逐步實現產品迭代升級與市場多元化發展，並且將努力把業務模式由中小企業，私營業主等建築渠道銷售的TP廠轉型為具備供應世界頂尖汽車玻璃生產廠商的供應商，提高本公司產品在全球市場的佔有率和影響力。

本公司認為因更多的業務領域逐漸使用本集團產品，基於此趨勢，未來本集團的產品市場份額將會持續擴大。在多元化發展業務以應對挑戰的同時，本集團將在仔細研判市場動態與趨勢後審慎擴張生產線及開展研發項目，以滿足未來的市場預期需求。與此同時，董事將密切注視經濟變化，維持審慎穩健的策略，積極應對前方的挑戰與機遇。

財務回顧

收入

截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月的收入為人民幣95.1百萬元，較二零二五年同期的人民幣70.3百萬元增加人民幣24.8百萬元或35.3%。增加主要是由於智能調光產品的銷售增加。

銷售成本及毛利

截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月的銷售成本為人民幣64.0百萬元，較二零二五年同期的人民幣41.2百萬元增加人民幣22.8百萬元或55.3%。銷售成本上升主要由於銷量增加及原材料價格上漲。

Our gross profit increased by RMB2.0 million or 6.9%, from RMB29.1 million for the six months ended 30 June 2025 to RMB31.1 million for the six months ended 30 June 2026. Our gross profit margin decreased from 41.4% for the six months ended 30 June 2025 to 32.7% for the six months ended 30 June 2026. The decrease was mainly attributable to the higher price of raw materials for Smart PDLC products.

Selling and Distribution Expenses

Our selling and distribution expenses were RMB2.8 million for the six months ended 30 June 2026, which represented an increase of RMB0.7 million, or 33.3% from RMB2.1 million for the same period in 2025. The expenses mainly included remuneration for sales and marketing employees based on sales performances and expenses relating to the Group's marketing efforts in business promotion and participation in exhibitions. The ratio of selling and distribution expenses to revenue remained at 2.9% for the six months ended 30 June 2026, as compared to the same period in 2025.

Administrative Expenses

Our administrative expenses were RMB14.4 million for the six months ended 30 June 2026, which represented an increase of approximately RMB1.9 million, or 15.2% from RMB12.5 million for the same period in 2025. The ratio of administrative expenses to revenue was 15.1% for the six months ended 30 June 2026, as compared to 17.8% for the same period in 2025.

Liquidity, Financial Resources and Capital Structure

Our Group's primary use of cash is to satisfy our working capital and capital expenditure needs. Historically, our Group's use of cash has mainly been financed through a combination of cash received from the sales of our products and financial support from our Group's related parties.

毛利由截至二零二五年六月三十日止六個月的人民幣29.1百萬元增加人民幣2.0百萬元或6.9%至截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月的人民幣31.1百萬元。毛利率由截至二零二五年六月三十日止六個月的41.4%下降至截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月的32.7%。該下降主要由於智能調光產品的原材料價格上升。

銷售及分銷開支

截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月，我們的銷售及分銷開支為人民幣2.8百萬元，較二零二五年同期的人民幣2.1百萬元增加人民幣0.7百萬元或33.3%。該等開支主要包括根據銷售業績的銷售及營銷員工之報酬，以及與本集團業務推廣及參與展覽相關的營銷工作開支。與二零二五年同期相比，截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月的銷售及分銷開支佔收入比例保持2.9%不變。

行政開支

截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月，我們的行政開支為人民幣14.4百萬元，較二零二五年同期的人民幣12.5百萬元增加約人民幣1.9百萬元或15.2%。截至二零二六年六月三十日止六個月的行政開支佔收入的比例為15.1%，而二零二五年同期為17.8%。

流動資金、財務資源及資本架構

本集團的現金主要用於滿足我們的營運資金及資本開支需要。以往，本集團的現金使用主要透過綜合從銷售產品及本集團關連方財務支持所獲得的現金予以撥付。

As at 30 June 2026, the Group had outstanding bank loans of approximately RMB35,000,000. Going forward, we believe that our liquidity requirements will be satisfied using a combination of cash generated from operating activities, bank borrowings and proceeds from the Listing. Our Directors believe that in the long run, our Group's operation will be funded by internally generated cash flows and, if necessary, additional equity and/or debt financing.

Capital Expenditure

For the six months ended 30 June 2026, our capital expenditure amounted to RMB13,375,007 (six months ended 30 June 2025: RMB11,928,277), which was mainly attributable to the improvement of production plant and purchase of production machinery and equipment from a number of independent suppliers.

Equity Ratio

Equity ratio is calculated by dividing the total liabilities by total equity at the end of the reporting period. At 30 June 2026, our equity ratio was 65% (31 December 2025: 48.4%).

Capital Commitments

At 30 June 2026, the Group had no capital commitments (31 December 2025: Nil).

Contingent Liabilities

At 30 June 2026, the Group had no significant contingent liabilities (31 December 2025: Nil).

Pledge of Assets

At 30 June 2026, the Group had no pledge of assets (31 December 2025: Nil).

Significant Investments, Acquisitions and Disposals

The Group did not make any material acquisition or disposal of subsidiaries, associates and joint ventures, or hold significant investments during the six months ended 30 June 2026.

Future Plans for Material Investments or Capital Assets

Save as disclosed in this report, the Group did not have any other future plans for material investments or capital assets as at the date of this report.

Foreign Currency Exposure

The Group's principal businesses are located in Chinese Mainland and most of the transactions are conducted in RMB, USD and Euro. Most of the Group's assets and liabilities are denominated in RMB, except for those of the overseas subsidiary in Hong Kong and the Company whose functional currency is HK\$. The Group's exposure to exchange rate risk is therefore limited. The Group will continue to monitor its foreign exchange position and, if necessary, utilise hedging tools to manage its foreign currency exposure (if any).

IMPAIRMENT LOSS ON TRADE RECEIVABLES

There was no impairment loss on trade receivables of the Group for the six months ended 30 June 2026.

Inputs Used or Key Assumptions Adopted for the Impairment Valuation

The Group carried out an assessment on the recoverable amount of trade receivables and estimated the amount of the expected credit loss (the “ECL”) of trade receivables.

The valuation of trade receivables considered ECL method, in which the ECL is based on the assessments considering exposure at default, probability of default, and expected recovery rates from default, adjusted with forward-looking factor.

The key assumptions and inputs adopted in the estimation of the amount of the ECL of trade receivables valuation are as follows:

- (i) Estimation of exposure at default: For trade receivables that do not contain a significant financing component or when the Group applies the practical expedient without adjusting for the effect of a significant financing component, the Group adopts a simplified approach in calculating ECLs. Under the simplified approach, the Group does not track changes in credit risk, but instead recognises a loss allowance based on lifetime ECLs at each reporting date. The Group has established a provision matrix based on its historical credit loss experience, adjusted for forward-looking factors specific to the debtors and the economic environment.
- (ii) Estimation of probability of default: The forecasted probabilities of default of trade receivables as at valuation date were based on historical default rates, which were collected from Moody's default study, and forward-looking factors, which were based on regression analysis. Regression input includes GDP growth rate and unemployment rate.
- (iii) Estimation of expected recovery rate: All trade receivables with ageing of over three years are assumed to be fully impaired. Since the customers have outstanding debts that have been past due for a certain period of time, the recovery probability from these customers is questionable.

減值估值所採用之輸入數據或所採納之主要假設

本集團已對應收貿易款項可收回金額進行評估，並估計應收貿易款項之預期信貸虧損（「預期信貸虧損」）金額。

應收貿易款項之估值已考慮預期信貸虧損法，其中預期信貸虧損乃按違約風險、違約概率及預期虧損收回率等考慮因素計算，並已就前瞻性因素調整違約值。

於應收貿易款項估值之預期信貸虧損金額之估計中所採納之主要假設及輸入數據如下：

- (i) 有關違約風險敞口之預測：對於不包含重大融資成分的應收貿易款項或當集團應用不調整重大融資成分效應的實際簡化方法時，集團採用了簡化方法計算預期信貸虧損。在簡化方法下，集團不追蹤信用風險的變化，而是根據每個報告日期的終身預期信用損失確認損失準備。集團已建立一個基於其歷史信用損失經驗的撥備矩陣，並根據債務人和經濟環境的前瞻性因素進行調整。
- (ii) 有關違約概率之預測：於估值日期應收貿易款項之預計違約概率乃按過往違約率（其從穆迪之違約研究報告收集）及前瞻性因素（其基於回歸分析）為基準。回歸輸入數據包括國內生產總值增長率及失業率。
- (iii) 有關收回率之預測：所有賬齡超過3年的應收貿易款項乃假定為已悉數減值。由於客戶有未償還債務且超過若干時間，該等客戶之可收回機率存疑。

As it is the Company's assessment that as at valuation date, the recoverable amount of overdue trade receivables of the Group with ageing of over 3 years is low, ECL was provided. Accordingly, the allowance for expected credit losses for trade receivables has been made to the Group's unaudited consolidated financial statement for the six months ended 30 June 2026.

Valuation Method and Reason for Its Adoption

The Group's impairment assessment policy on trade receivables was set out in note 4 to the consolidated financial statements of the Company as included in the 2025 Annual Report.

The Group always recognises lifetime ECL for trade receivables and has applied the simplified approach under IFRS 9 to measure the loss allowance at lifetime ECL. Except for debtors with significant outstanding balances or who are credit-impaired, the Group determines the ECLs on these items using a provision matrix grouped by past due status.

In completing the valuation, reference was made to generally accepted approaches to the valuation of trade receivables, as well as IFRS 9 in relation to the disclosure and presentation, recognition and measurement of financial instruments.

Actions to Recover the Trade Receivables

While each case may have unique circumstances, the Company generally follows a series of steps to recover outstanding payments. Set out below are the usual actions undertaken by the Company:

1. Analysis and Communication
2. Reminder Notices
3. Payment Negotiation
4. Legal Actions
5. Debt Recovery Agencies

It is important to note that the specific actions taken may vary depending on the nature of the debt, the debtor's financial condition, legal considerations and cost implications in recovering the debts. The Group's priority is to maintain open lines of communication, explore mutually beneficial solutions, and ensure fair treatment of all parties involved.

By following these usual actions, the Group aims to maximise the chances of recovering trade receivables while preserving relationships with our valued clients. Our dedicated team remains committed to resolving outstanding balances promptly and efficiently.

本集團一直就應收貿易款項確認存續期預期信貸虧損，並應用國際財務報告準則第9號中的簡化方法計量存續期預期信貸虧損之虧損撥備。除有大量未償還結餘或信貸減值之債務人外，本集團均採用按逾期狀況分組之撥備矩陣釐定該等項目之預期信貸虧損。

在完成估值時，已參考就應收貿易款項之公認估值方法，及有關金融工具之披露及呈列、確認及計量之國際財務報告準則第9號。

收回應收貿易款項的行動

雖然每個個案可能都有獨特的情況，但公司通常會採取一系列步驟來收回未付款項。以下為公司通常採取的行動：

1. 分析與溝通
2. 提醒通知
3. 付款協商
4. 法律訴訟
5. 債務追償機構

值得注意的是，所採取的具體行動可能會根據債務的性質、債務人的財務狀況、法律考慮以及追回債務的成本影響而有所不同。集團的首要任務是保持開放的溝通渠道，探索互利的解決方案，並確保所有相關方得到公平對待。

透過遵循這些常規行動，集團旨在最大限度地提高收回應收貿易款項的機會，同時維護與尊貴客戶的關係。我們的專業團隊始終致力於迅速有效地解決未清餘額。

The business strategies as set out in the prospectus dated 30 June 2017 (the “Prospectus”) were based on the best estimation of the future market conditions made by the Group at the time of preparing the Prospectus. The use of proceeds was applied in accordance with the actual development of the market.

As at 30 June 2026, approximately HK\$88.6 million out of the net proceeds from the Share Offer had been used. The unutilized net proceeds have been deposited in licensed banks.

The Company intends to apply the net proceeds in the manner consistent with that set out in the Prospectus to the extent appropriate. However, the actual use of proceeds was lower than planned use of proceeds because of the delay in automation and installation of production lines. In response to the rapidly changing business environment, it has taken more time than expected to look for suitable machinery and equipment producers which could meet our production requirements. Also, our plan of installing new production line has been shelved temporarily due to the unstable environment and keen competition thereafter. The Directors will constantly evaluate the Group's business strategies and may change or modify plans against the changing market condition to attain sustainable business growth of the Group.

Dividends

The Board does not recommend the payment of an interim dividend for the six months ended 30 June 2026 (2025: Nil).

EMPLOYEES AND REMUNERATION POLICIES

As at 30 June 2026, we had a total headcount of 131 full-time and part-time employees (2025: 115). The remuneration package of our employees includes basic salary, allowances and bonuses. The various allowances cover holidays, social security and housing contributions. We make contributions to all mandatory social security and housing provident funds for our employees.

The Directors' fees are subject to shareholders' approval at annual general meetings. Other employments are determined by the Board with reference to Directors' duties, responsibilities, their experience and qualifications, the prevailing market rate and performance and the results of the Group.

本公司在適當情況下擬按照招股章程所述方式動用所得款項淨額。然而，由於生產線的自動化和安裝延遲，所得款項的實際使用低於所得款項的計劃使用。為應對瞬息萬變的營商環境，尋找能夠滿足我們生產要求的適合機器及設備生產商需要耗費比預期更多的時間。再者，由於不穩定的環境與激烈的競爭的緣故，安裝新生產線的計劃暫時被擱置。董事將持續評估本集團的業務策略，並可能因應不斷變化的市況更改或修訂計劃，以達至本集團的可持續業務增長。

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

China Shuifa Singyes New Materials Holdings Limited (the “Company”) is a limited liability company incorporated in Bermuda. The registered office of the Company is located at Richmond House, 12 Par-la-Ville Road, Hamilton HM 08, Bermuda. The principal place of business of the Company in Hong Kong is located at Unit 3108, 31/F, China Merchants Tower, Shun Tak Center, 168-200 Connaught Road Central, Hong Kong.

During the six months ended 30 June 2026, the Company and its subsidiaries (collectively referred to as the “Group”) were principally engaged in the sale and installation of Indium Tin Oxide (“ITO”) film, and research and development, production, sale and installation of Smart Polymer-Dispersed Liquid Crystals (“PDLC”) products, Light Emitting Diode (“LED”) Display and Projection System in the People’s Republic of China (the “PRC”). There were no significant changes in the nature of the Group’s principal activities during the period.

In the opinion of the directors of the Company (the “Directors”), the immediate holding company and the ultimate holding company of the Company are China Shuifa Singyes Energy Holdings Limited (“Shuifa Singyes”) and Shuifa Group Co., Ltd. (“Shuifa Group”), respectively. Shuifa Singyes was incorporated in Bermuda and its shares are listed on the Main Board of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited. Shuifa Group is a state-owned enterprise established in the PRC and controlled by The Shandong Provincial State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission.

2. BASIS OF PREPARATION
